The ePoster presentation offers you a valuable opportunity to deliver a brief oral presentation to an international audience of professionals working in your field of expertise. Presentations will take place at designated ePoster stations located in the ePoster Area onsite in Cape Town.

Your ePoster will also be available for open viewing throughout the Congress at any station.

High-definition screens will showcase your poster, allowing you to highlight your data and share your findings in a professional and interactive environment. Each session will be led by a moderator.

Presenters will have **5 minutes** for their oral presentation, followed by a Q&A segment designed to encourage constructive feedback and professional exchange.

Presentations will be scheduled during the lunch breaks to maximise attendance and engagement. You are welcome to bring printed handouts to distribute during your ePoster presentation, if desired.

Please note: No printing or physical production of posters is required, as all presentations will be delivered electronically.

ePoster specifications

- **Format:** PPT or PPTX only (16:9 landscape orientation, single slide).
- **PDF format is not accepted.**
- **One single slide only.**

ePoster Design and Content Guidelines

Content guidelines

- Include your new abstract number in the upper right corner of the ePoster (mandatory).
- Avoid overloading your ePoster with text - you are not writing an article.
- Strive for simplicity: keep text concise and avoid redundancies.
- FIGO encourages innovative ePoster presentation styles and recommends consulting the following resources:

- You might include QR codes linking to relevant scientific content.
- Prepare a brief oral presentation lasting less than 5 minutes.

Reader engagement tips

- The average viewer spends 1–2 minutes on a poster; focus on clarity and visual flow.
- Position conclusions at eye level or lead with them for maximum impact.

- Structure your poster with the following sections: Introduction, Methods, Results, and Conclusions.
- Use a downward flow layout (3 columns) to guide the reader naturally.
- Handouts of your abstract or poster (including your contact details) may facilitate future research communication.

- To avoid compatibility issues between PC and Mac, use only common fonts such as Arial, Courier, Courier New, Geneva, Georgia, Helvetica, Times, or Times New Roman.
